Public Comment

New Business

Mr. Wilson made a request to change the pay rate for using the chipper to be included in the heavy equipment pay rate. It will remain at the laborer rate.

Mr. Wilson made a request for the township to place signs for the fire department at the ends of long lanes to help the fire department determine how many trucks would be needed due to hose lengths. The township will not be placing these signs.
