

The Board met for a Budget Workshop on Tuesday, October 27, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. Bryan Cummings, Richard Wilson, and Rayburn Campbell were in attendance.

Budget:

The following will be considered for the 2021 Budget:

- Additional Single Sealcoating all of Briarwood (875'x18' plus cul-de-sac), Borowicz Road (4805'x18'), and portions of Bend Road (2525'x18'), and Ferris Road (3030'x18'). Budgeted out of State Fund.
- Quotes will be sought for a road drag/maintainer. If purchased would be paid half out of the Capital Preservation Fund and half from the General Fund. \$15,000 total was budgeted for this item.

The following will be budgeted from the General Fund:

- Equipment maintenance/repair - Mower flails will be budgeted for \$1600.00.
- Building/Grounds - New flooring in the community room: \$6500.00. LED lights in both garage and community room: \$1200.00. Painting of community room will be added once a quote is received.

Other Business

The letter and guidelines to be sent out from Tri-County to residents in November were reviewed.

Mr. Cummings made a motion to appoint Cindy Black as delegate to the Lawrence County Tax Collector Committee, seconded by Mr. Campbell. Roll call vote: Bryan Cummings - yes; Richard Wilson - yes; Rayburn Campbell - yes.

The trucks will get undercoated this year.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
