

The Wilmington Township Mercer County Board of Supervisors met on July 9, 2019, in the township building. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by William Roth, with Richard Wilson and Bryan Cummings in attendance. Guests are on attached sign in sheet. The pledge to the flag was given.

Public Comment

John and Shirley Martin questioned whether a property they are looking at purchasing could be tied into the current sewer line. Because of the easement that exists between that property and VCC, they or the current owner would need to extend the main sewer line across the road to the end of the property at Cowden Road in order to tie in.

Sewer Business

Tom Thompson of Gannett Fleming explained that the income for the township exceeds the threshold for RUS grants, the cost per EDU has gone up to \$111 for a non grant project. This would include a \$3000 tap fee. Mercer County typically sees on average \$70 for their rates. A future reassessment of income could change funding opportunities in the future.

Prior malfunctions were at 57%. With including the additional site visits that were required of DEP, the malfunction rate has held steady at 57%.

Mr. Thompson will send the Board information on alternative options to include in the Plan regarding how to handle developments after the issuance of PaDEP permits to secure funding.

A motion will need to be made at an upcoming meeting to advertise for public comments.
