New Business

Roads/Equipment/Streams/Employees:

- It was decided that the roads due for seal coating this year (Auction Road, Number 8 Road, Orchard Road, Bend Road, and Mill Road) will have the berms cut, potholes filled and ditching done. Mr. Cummings will drive along the roads to see what other projects can be done in-house.
- Buddy Miller from PennDot measured and gave advice on possible contracted work for Anderson Road cutoff, Brenneman Road, East Branch Road and White Chapel Road.

- Mr. Cummings will be checking on the culverts that are steel to see which need replaced this year. Angel Road and Indian Run Road have possible culverts to replace.
- The supervisors decided that the township roads do not need tree trimming for this year.
- Private Drive signs for driveways will be at the owner's expense.

The 2024 township audit is completed with no findings.
