

The Wilmington Township Mercer County Board of Supervisors met for a Budget Workshop on Wednesday, October 2, 2025 at 7:01 p.m. to discuss budget items. Joseph Whiting, Robert Steingrabe, and Donald Bolinger were present. Richard Wilson was in attendance.

- Discussion took place about getting the roads on a three-year rotation for sealcoating and road edge repairs, with Number 8 Road, Orchard Road, Mill Road, Bend Road, and Auction Road up for the rotation. Optional work on Briarwood Lane, Willow Drive, and Valley View Road.
- Discussion took place on possibly fixing White Chapel Road.
- Discussion took place about a JCB Hydradig that would be purchased through the LSA grant. Information will be gathered for attachment options.
- Discussion took place on purchasing an air compressor for the garage.
- Discussion took place regarding the block between the garage doors as well as possible concrete work on the aprons in front of the garage doors. Another quote will be received.
- It will be budgeted for one supervisor and secretary to attend PSATS convention.
- A \$500 donation will be given to the Volant Fire Department, \$4000 to the New Wilmington Borough Fire Department, and \$1000 to the Mercer Area Library.
- Monies from the sale of the 2008 Ford will be put in the General Fund.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:33 p.m. with a motion from Mr. Bolinger, seconded by Mr. Whiting.
