

The Wilmington Township Mercer County Board of Supervisors met on April 8, 2026, at the township building. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Bryan Cummings, with Robert Steingrabe and Joseph Whiting in attendance. Guests present were: Vickie Shaffer, Bryan Sullivan, James Gilliland, Cory Eckels, DJ Bolinger, and Pastor Rob Cypher. The pledge to the flag was given.

### Public Comment

Kristen Johnson from EADS phoned in to discuss the first amendment to the sewer agreement. She discussed the possibility of adding both a master meter and a deduct meter to the agreement. A payment plan option was decided upon at the meeting. The preliminary design for the sewer project will be complete by the end of May, and Environmental Plans will be ready for submission.

- The culvert on Indian Run Road will be addressed by the supervisors
- Quotes are being obtained for the grates on hill of Bend Road
- Ditching will begin on all 2026 seal coated roads
- Decisions regarding White Chapel/Anderson Road Cutoff/Brenneman were tabled until the next meeting

Cyber security was discussed, including a proposal and quote for technology services from Reeves Info Tech in Greenville. Additional details are needed including length of contract, etc.

The New Wilmington Borough Fire Department attended the meeting to discuss territory lines for fire response. Mrs. Harvey will contact the Mercer County Planning Commission regarding maps of territory lines.

A Joint Seal Coat meeting will take place on April 16, 2026 at 9am in Coolspring Township.
