Public Comment

Township Reports

There was nothing to report for the MPO, MCRPC, and MCRCOG meetings.

Unfinished Business

The sewer project blueprints were reviewed to discuss the design plans connecting Maplewood Lane to Cowden Road. Mr. Steingrabe made a motion to leave the design plans as is without changes, Mr. Whiting seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Bryan Cummings – yes, Joseph Whiting – yes, Robert Steingrabe – yes.

Mr. Steingrabe made a motion to approve that the township would cover as a maximum up to 150 feet in order for a resident to tie into the sewer lines, seconded by Mr. Whiting. Roll call vote: Bryan Cummings – yes, Joseph Whiting – yes, Robert Steingrabe – yes.

Ditching was completed on Auction, Orchard, and Number 8 Road. Bend and Mill Road still need ditched. Work will start on the grooves and potholes on each of these roads this month.

We have not received any quotes on the culvert on Angel Road. The supervisors are looking into the cost of completing it in-house.

New Business

The planning commission did not meet.

The results were read from the Zoning Hearing Board meeting. The board granted Tom Norris a variance to build a garage.

Ms. Harvey discussed Ryan Morse's interest in becoming an Emergency Management Coordinator.

Robert Killmer brought Sewage Facilities Planning Module paperwork to be signed by the supervisors to send into the DEP in order to get a no build application. Mr. Whiting made a motion to sign the paperwork, Mr. Steingrabe seconded. Roll call vote: Bryan Cummings – yes, Joseph Whiting – yes, Robert Steingrabe – yes.

Due to schedule conflicts in August and September, Mr. Steingrabe made a motion to change the Board of Supervisor's Meetings to August 6th at 7 pm and September 3rd at 7 pm. Mr. Whiting seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Bryan Cummings – yes, Joseph Whiting – yes, Robert Steingrabe – yes.

Jefferson Township is sponsoring a UTV ride on October 10, 2026. Mr. Steingrabe made a motion to allow the ATVs and UTVs on our township roads, Mr. Whiting seconded. Roll call vote: Bryan Cummings – yes, Joseph Whiting – yes, Robert Steingrabe – yes.
